He is the ophthalmologist responsible for strabologic pathology of the IMO (the Ocular Microsurgery Institute of Barcelona).

He has presented numerous papers at various conferences on ophthalmology and has lectured on several courses on oculomotor pathology and children's ophthalmic pathology aimed at ophthalmologists and paediatricians.
